RE: Revised Bulletin 11-32: Certificate of Compliance for Advertising,

Code of Maryland Regulations ("COMAR") 31.15.02.18B

This Bulletin amends Bulletin 11-32, which was issued on November 10, 2011. The purpose of this Bulletin is to remind each carrier¹ required to file an annual statement² with the Insurance Commissioner that, together with its annual statement, it must also file a Certificate of Compliance. The requirement to file a Certificate of Compliance was added to the "Reports Due from Regulated Entities to the Maryland Insurance Administration" in 2010. Certificate of Compliance

COMAR 31.15.02.18B provides that, "each carrier or producer required to file an annual statement³ which is now or which hereafter becomes subject to the provisions of this chapter shall file with the Commissioner together with its annual statement, a certificate executed by an authorized officer of the carrier or producer in which it is stated that to the best of the officer's knowledge, information, and belief the advertisements which were disseminated by the carrier or producer during the preceding statement year complied or were made to comply in all respects with the provisions of the Insurance Laws of Maryland and the regulations issued thereunder by the State Insurance Commissioner." Note: Producers are not required to submit a certificate of compliance for advertising at this time.

To facilitate and promote uniformity in filing the Certificate of Compliance, the Commissioner adopted a Certificate of Compliance (Advertising) form ("Form"). This Form should be submitted with the annual statement, which is due by March 1st of each year.
