## Wellfleet Insurance Company Maryland Network Adequacy Access Plan 2020 – with Cigna PPO Executive Summary

Wellfleet Insurance Company (“Wellfleet”) partners with the Cigna PPO Network to provide network services to Wellfleet members in Maryland. Wellfleet provides this Executive Summary for our 2020 Maryland Network Adequacy Access Plan filing.

### 1. Travel Distance Standards:

**Nurse Practitioners:** Nurse Practitioners provide primary care services to Cigna enrollees in accordance with our policy; however, Cigna’s reporting system does not currently distinguish Nurse Practitioners by specialty.

**Essential Community Providers (ECP):** Below please find the list of the total number of essential community providers in the network and the total percentage of essential community providers available in the service area who are participating providers.

\*The wait time standards are determined through third party assessment as opposed to first hand data directly from providers. As a result, they are an approximation of what patients experience. This metric is affected by geographic distribution of providers and availability of certain specialties. Cigna's network is currently open and accepting providers and facilities that meet credentialing requirements and will agree to contract terms. Note that Telemedicine/Telehealth appointments are not currently captured in the Appointment Waiting Time Analysis.
