Re: HB0212 / SB0155 - Noise Abatement Violations not to be used for insurance purposes – Effective July 1, 2024

The Maryland Insurance Administration (the "Administration") is issuing this Bulletin to assure that all carriers authorized to write motor vehicle insurance in the State are aware of the passage of House Bill 0212 / Senate Bill 0155, which was enacted in the 2024 legislative session and will become effective on July 1, 2024.

<u>House Bill 0212 / Senate Bill 0155</u> amends Section 22-612 of the Transportation Article to create a pilot program authorizing the use of noise abatement monitoring systems in Montgomery County and Prince George's County to enforce certain motor vehicle noise requirements. This legislation creates civil penalties for vehicle owners that violate motor vehicle noise requirements.

Section 22-612(I)(4) provides that such civil violations may not be used in the issuance or renewal of motor vehicle insurance coverage. The penalties may not be considered by insurers in their rates, rules, forms, or underwriting decisions.
