To: All Property and Casualty Insurers, the Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund (MAIF) and the Joint Insurance Association (JIA)

Re: Claims Filed as a Direct or Indirect Result of the February Snow Storm (CAT 92 and CAT 94)

Governor Martin O'Malley is treating the snow storms, which have been classified as CAT 92 and CAT 94, as one event. Therefore, when processing all property damage claims, insurers should take all reasonable steps to impose one deductible for all property damage claims filed as a direct or indirect result of the February snow storm (CAT 92 and CAT 94). Insurers should provide copies of this Bulletin to their producers, adjusters (internal and independent) and claims personnel.
