Meeting Topics and Summaries

Opening Remarks

Mary Kwei, Associate Commissioner, Market Regulation & Professional Licensing made a motion to approve the June 10, 2025 meeting minutes. The motion was seconded and the motion passed.

Producer Advisory Board New Members

Mary Kwei opened the floor for the newly appointed board members to introduce themselves. Each member provided a brief overview of their experience in the insurance industry.

Valid Exam Score Duration Discussion

Mary Kwei discussed the exam validation timeframe. The administration expressed a desire to align with practices in other states and requested the Advisory Boards input on how long an exam should remain valid after passing. The Advisory Board provided feedback and recommended implementing this requirement, stating applicants should be required to retake the exam after one year.

Enforcement Statistic Report- Jeff Gross

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Mary Kwei introduced Jeff Gross, Chief of Licensing Compliance and Management Initiatives. Jeff Gross discussed the enforcement statistics currently being compiled by the Licensing Unit. Jeff Gross presented the data from the beginning of this fiscal year, starting in July. He outlined the functions of both the Fraud and the Enforcement Units and clarified the distinctions between them.

Kwei reiterated that the Administration is always available to received complaints related to Property and Casualty, Life and Health, and Medical Necessity denials. Kwei also expressed the importance of submitting necessary complaints in order for the administration to stay abreast in the industry.

Gross presented the Administration's website and demonstrated where individuals may submit a complaint. Kwei then opened the floor for more questions and thanked Gross for his presentation.

Exam Review Workshop

Lorelei Brillante, Assistant Director of Professional Licensing provided and overview of the Exam Review Workshop (ERW) and informed the Advisory Board that their participation is essential for evaluating and updating exam questions that may be outdated. The ERW is scheduled for November 12th and 13th.

Brillante opened the floor for questions and invited previous members to share their insights based on prior meetings.
