**PRODUCER LICENSE EXAM REIMBURSEMENT FOR ELIGIBLE VETERANS**

- The Department of Veterans Affairs can reimburse the cost of approved licensing and certification **tests**. Eligible Veterans may be reimbursed the cost of the **test**, or up to \$2,000.
- Veterans may be eligible for benefits even if they did not pass the **test**. Also, benefits may be available for Veterans who incur **test** fees in order to be recertified or to renew a license.
