Regulation .03A: The change to the proposed text replaces the agency's ability to determine an institutional submission date on an annual basis with specific dates based on the agency's current practices. This change could reasonably have been anticipated by the institutions affected and assists the institutions by adding certainty and consistency to the process. It does not substantially affect the rights, duties, or obligations of a member of the public or of any institution of higher education making a submission, and is therefore nonsubstantive.
